Syndrome X, also known as cardiometabolic syndrome, is generally diagnosed when a patient has three of five interrelated conditions: (1) excessive belly fat (waist circumference - women > 35"/ men > 40"); (2) high triglycerides > 150; (3) low HDL ("good" cholesterol that carries LDL out of the body) < 50; (4) high blood pressure over 130/85 (normal is
